
Smart Phone





Introductory:

A- Literature → People → Hardware → Software → Internet (Use/Misuse)

[Details on YouTube channel, 'Sermons Ross Nazirullah' from 'Playlists' look, 'Divine Guidance'] Looking the images in 1931 online time spent was 0% and with the family was 22.7% and in 2024 time spent with the family was 0.75% and online time spent was 60.8%. In 2025 the average screen time for US teenagers is 7 hours & 22 minutes, almost half of their waking hours.

B – Communication: i) Tablets → Internet

He gave him the two <u>tablets</u> of the covenant law, the tablets of stone inscribed by the finger of God. (Exodus 31:18) → Internet- And for three and a half days, <u>all peoples</u>, tribes, languages, and nations will stare at their bodies. (Revelation 11:9)[only possible through <u>internet</u>]

ii) Humans - post card (postal mail) → email (internet) → Online (audio/video)

It was sent the <u>letters by mounted couriers</u> riding on swift horses to all the 127 provinces, to each in its own script, stretching from India to Ethiopia. (Esther 8:9-10)

- 1) Biblical Literature: i)Tablets Genesis/Exodus
- ii)Scrolls good (2 Timothy 4:13); bad(Acts 19:19)

iii)Books – good (Daniel 9:2); bad (Pornography) → get involved with evil world

Right use of books (by checking the publishers whether right doctrine or wrong doctrine) \rightarrow getting proper knowledge by using God given sense.

Wrong use of books (without checking their publishers- may be from evil world)

- 2) Through people: Through prophets (Deut. 18:18), ministers (1 Kings 13:6).
- 3) Through objects (hardware)

Right use of hardware \rightarrow get proper helpful stuff for life; but wrong use \rightarrow wasting time.

i) Brazen serpent

Moses made a brazen serpent to save lives later became idol for them.

Numbers 21:8 (gave life) → 2 Kings 18:4 (became idol)

- ii) Ephod- (a sacred vest)- was good (1 Samuel 30:8); became idol (Judges 8:27)
- 4) Online (Software): As we see: (i) Computer \rightarrow (ii) Google \rightarrow (iii) GPS \rightarrow (iv) AI
- i) Computer: (a) Good (after login) looking helpful stuff for your life.
 - i.e. for body, soul and spirit (1 Thessalonians 5:23)
- (b) Bad (may be without login) looking the stuff harmful for your life.
- ii) Google/online search, good as i) (a) mentioned above and bad as i) (b) mentioned above.

Online browser is very smart it would bring first what you search most!

Temptation of youth is more that is why some countries have made ban on kids.

Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it. (Prov. 22:6)

iii) GPS: (GPS do not say you are wrong instead may politely guide for diversion! But Holy Spirit resists your wrong path.

After being forbidden by the <u>Holy Spirit</u> to speak the word in Asia; they were trying to go into Bithynia, and the Spirit of Jesus did not allow them. (Acts 16:6-7)

- iv) AI- good if properly used, becomes bad if completely depend on it without using our God given sense. Also see: (i)Daniel 12:4 \rightarrow (ii)Revelation 11:9 \rightarrow (iii)Some countries ban \rightarrow (iv)Hosea 4:12
- (i) Creative mind/creativity: In last days *Until the time of the end. Many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall increase*. (Daniel 12:4); Here knowledge shall increase means not multiply but rapid or exponentially increase (using a math term).
- "See, I have called by name Bezalel, and I have filled him with the Spirit of God in wisdom, in understanding, in knowledge, and in all kinds of craftsmanship, to <u>create</u> artistic designs for work in gold, in silver, and in bronze. (Exodus 31:2-4)
- (ii) It is possible only through online/internet- And for three and a half days, all peoples, tribes, languages, and nations will stare at their bodies. (Revelation 11:9)
- (iii) Several countries have banned or restricted children's Smartphone, particularly in schools. e.g. South Korea, Netherlands, Australia, and France.
- (iv) [Mislead]-My people consult their wooden idols, and their divining rods inform them. (Hosea 4:12)

Misuse

i) Looking/Reading

Do not <u>look</u> at wine when it is red; in the end it bites like a snake, and stings like a viper. (Prov. 23:31-32) The sense of vision is dominant over other senses. A significantly larger portion of the brain is dedicated to processing visual information than for any other single sense

- ii) Evil communications corrupt good manners. (1 Corinthians 15:33)
- iii) Ideal/god: Some good stuff should not be made ideal/god.

He who finds a wife finds what is good and receives favor from the LORD. (Proverbs 18:22)

But when someone makes woman his ideal/god like Heer-Ranjha, Romeo and Juliet, Sohni-Mahiwal, Sassi-Pannu, that makes destruction to his life.

iv) Wrong teaching

Jesus says, "Watch out!" Jesus told them. "Beware of the yeast [teaching] of the Pharisees and Sadducees." (Matthew 16:6,11-12)

Also

In Church

- i) For youth with smart phone Are you in touch with worldly affairs or with God? No excuse that you use to look biblical verses! (The effectiveness of verses would go away as your mind is in online stuff!) *They worship me in vain*. (Matthew 15:9)
- ii) For Ministers- Are your contact is with people or with God in the Church!

Shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret. (Matthew 6:6)

So in the Church no contact should be with worldly affairs! Better to put your smart phone on vibration/silence.

Carrying always

- i) If you always carry with the excuse that you may get any time any message! Our 24 hours is not reserved for that!
- ii) Is God's constant presence is with you? You have encircled me behind and in front, and placed Your hand upon me. (Psalm 139:5)
- iii) During first landing on Moon of Apollo 11 (July 20, 1969), Neil Armstrong's heart rate was closely monitored from Earth, as surged from 70 to 150 bpm. It's no wonder God is watching constantly especially on His saved ones.

Guideline

An infant and doesn't know how to do what is right; those who are mature, who through training have the skill to recognize the difference between right and wrong. (Hebrews 5:13-14)

At teen age I read one wrong doctrine (from an occult publisher), after more than 50 years that thinking is still in my mind! Now before reading/watching some stuff, <u>I always first check its source/publisher</u>. <u>Two useful tips</u>

- i) Any nice stuff would be helpful if we use according to God's plan and it will become idol if we completely depend upon that stuff.
- ii) Its good to check the concerned online link (whether it is genuine or fake!)

Unsubscribe or block unwanted link.

One question

Do you use your smart phone according to God's planned online stuff or evil world's planned online stuff? It's not possible to use both!

Does a fountain send out from the same opening both fresh and bitter water? (James 3:11)

Summary:

God has given us a creative mind/sense of discerning; use your brain, do not be dependent online stuff without using God given sense.
